

PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING NOTICE

Re: 2024 Construction Project- Holt Road from US-127 to Okemos Road

Dear Resident:

A Public Information Meeting is scheduled for 5:30-7:00 pm on Wednesday, March 13, 2024 at the Alaiedon Township Hall, located at 2021 W. Holt Rd, Mason, MI 48854.

The Ingham County Road Department invites the public to attend an open house style meeting to discuss the upcoming construction on Holt Road, from US-127 to Okemos Road. The project includes the reconstruction of the roadway by rubblizing (breaking) the existing concrete pavement and placing an asphalt layer on top of the rubblized concrete.

The project is being completed in two phases. The Contractor is anticipated to begin Phase I in early April 2024, which is between Okemos Road and the northbound US-127 ramps. Completion of Phase I is expected by early July 2024. During this time, resident access will be maintained at all times, but the road will be closed to through traffic and detoured.

Phase II of the project will be between the northbound US-127 ramps and the east side of the US-127 overpass. Phase II is anticipated to begin in July 2024 with expected completion by September 2024. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction during Phase II of the project.

Project updates will be posted to the "Road Construction" page of the Ingham County Road Department website at www.roads.ingham.org throughout the project.

In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, the Road Department will provide necessary reasonable auxiliary aids and services for public meetings. Requests for interpretation, accommodations for persons with disabilities, and assistance with additional needs should be made as soon as possible, but no less than five (5) working days in advance of the meeting date.
