

Q1 What is your age?






Q3 If yes, how many years have you lived in Alaiedon Township?









Q8 Since Alaiedon Township does not currently have a park, other than the recreation facilities on the Township Hall grounds, how often do you visit any park?







Q12 What type of recreational facilities would you like to see developed in Alaiedon Township? (check all that apply)







Q14 If Alaiedon Township developed a township park with the facilities you support, how often would you utilize it?




